
During the training day, 13 young people, guided by an expert facilitator, had the opportunity to explore the issue of cyberbullying and hate speech.

During the workshop, the participants were able to analyze the various facets of the phenomenon and the psychological implications in the victims. Participants were also able to put themselves in the shoes of victims of cyber bullying in simulations devoted to the analysis and construction of a solution to the phenomenon.

Furthermore, the participants focused on identifying the contents and structure of an online platform to support victims, parents and institutions which could be a tool for recognizing, preventing and fighting cyberbullying.
